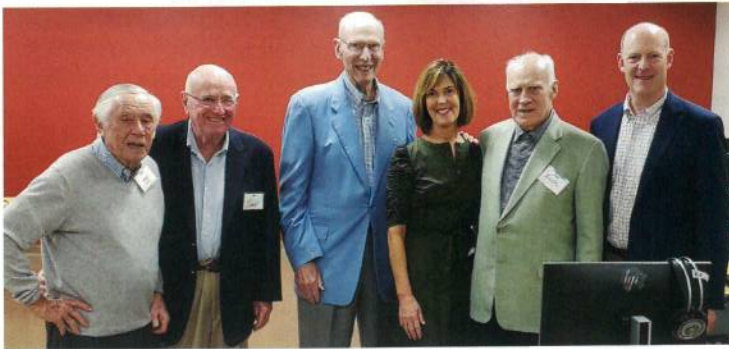

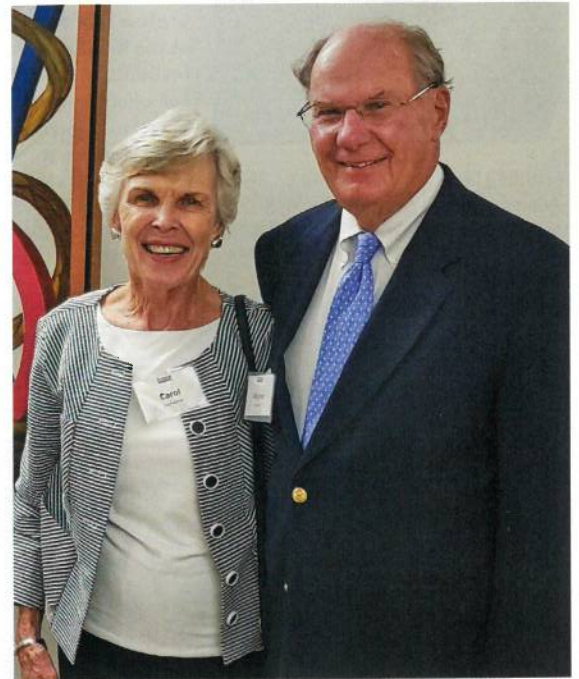

DREAM WEAVERS DONOR RECEPTION

GIFFORD YOUTH ACHIEVEMENT CENTER

On Feb. 19, donors gathered on the Freddie Woolfork patio at the Gifford Youth Achievement Center's new Cis and Bill Glavin Educational Center to celebrate the successful conclusion of the two-year Dream Weavers capital campaign that made the expansion possible. The campaign exceeded its goal of \$7.4 million, allowing for the construction of eight new classrooms, along with coverage of operational expenses for the first three years, as well as the establishment of an endowment fund. Now, GYAC will no longer have to place 40 to 50 students on a waiting list each year. Guests at the reception toasted all those who helped make this dream a reality, including EDB Architects; Proctor Construction; Dream Weaver honorary chair Scott Alexander of Northern Trust; co-chairs Lisa Holmes, Mary McKinney and Trudie Rainone; all the committee members; and the entire Gifford community.
